General Fund / Aid to Localities

6 Local Assistance Account - 001
7 For services and expenses, including the
8 payment of liabilities incurred prior to
9 April 1, 2003, related to the community
10 services elderly grant program. No expend-
11 itures shall be made from this appropri-
12 ation until the director of the budget has
13 approved a plan submitted by the office
14 outlining the amounts and purposes of such
15 expenditures and the allocation of funds
16 among the counties. Notwithstanding any
17 provision of law, rule or regulation to
18 the contrary, subject to the approval of
19 the director of the budget, funds appro-
20 priated herein for the community services
21 for the elderly program (CSE) and the
22 expanded in-home services for the elderly
23 program (EISEP) may be used in accordance
24 with a waiver or reduction in county main-
25 tenance of effort requirements established
26 pursuant to section 541 of the executive
27 law, except for base year expenditures. To
28 the extent that funds hereby appropriated
29 are sufficient to exceed the per capita
30 limit established in section 541 of the
31 executive law, the excess funds shall be
32 available to supplement the existing per
33 capita level in a uniform manner consist-
34 ent with statutory allocations 16,472,107

38 law, rule or regulation to the contrary,
39 these funds shall be allocated to the area
